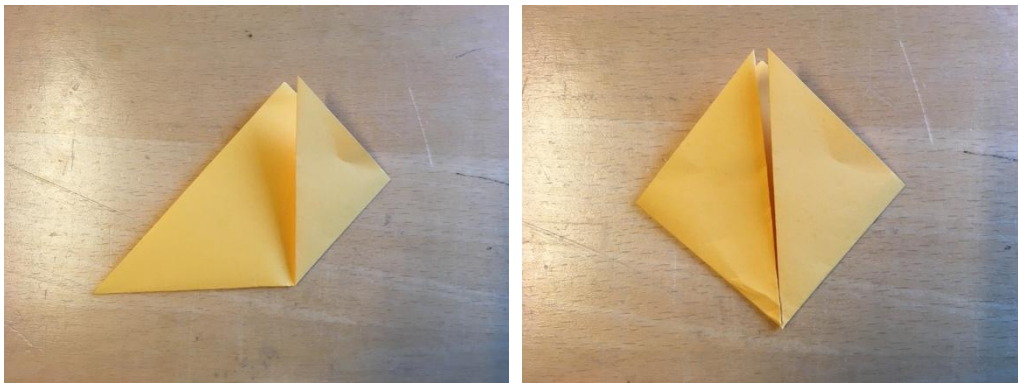
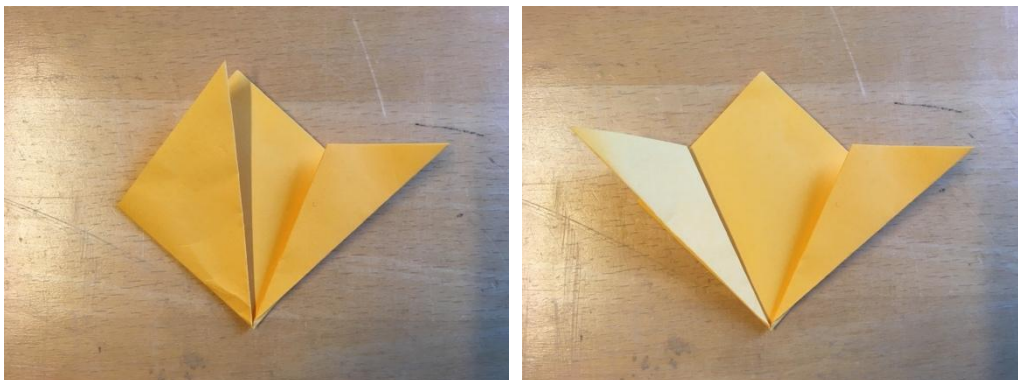


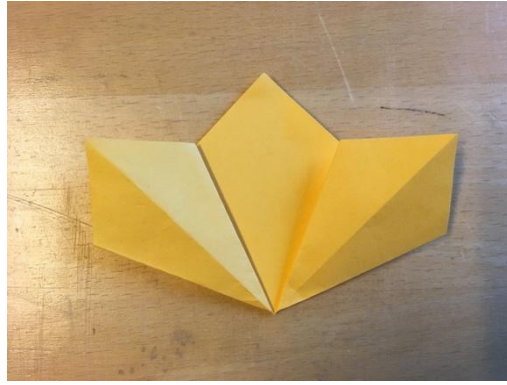
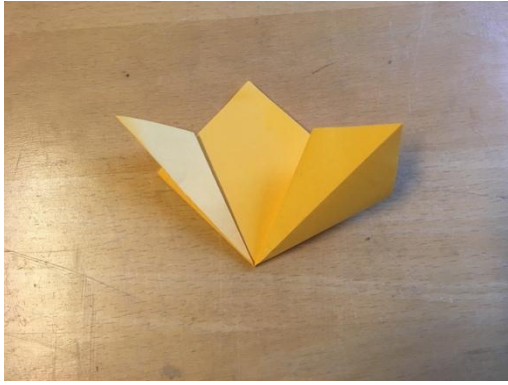
Fold piece of paper diagonally.



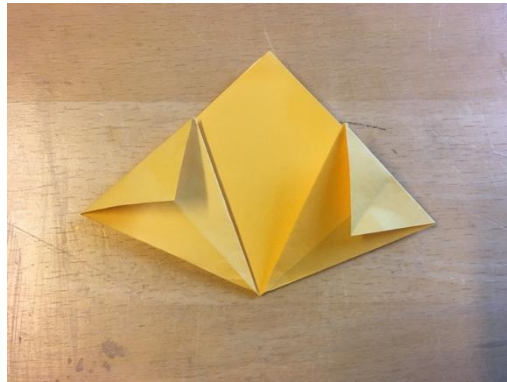
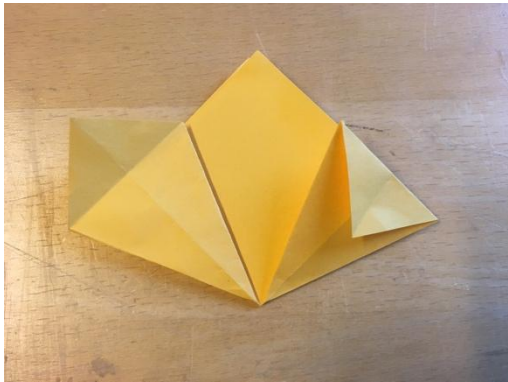
With the open end pointing upwards, fold in the points to make a diamond shape.



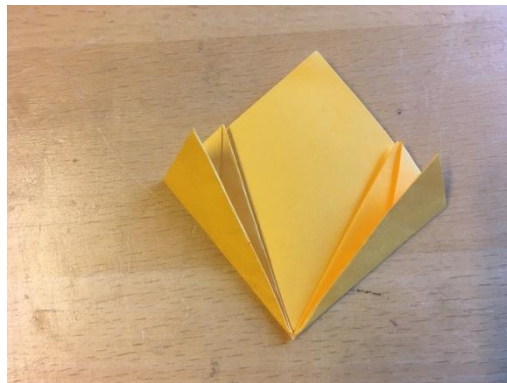
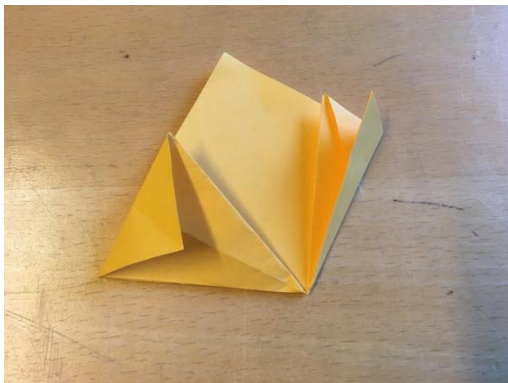
Fold back the flap so it aligns with outer edge of the diamond.
Repeat with the other side.



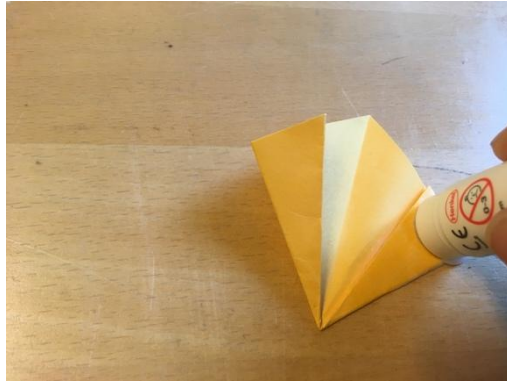
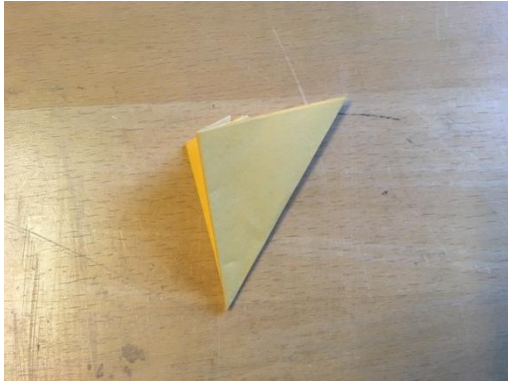
Unfold by popping your finger into the fold and pushing it out. Flatten the paper so the crease line is central. Repeat with the other side.



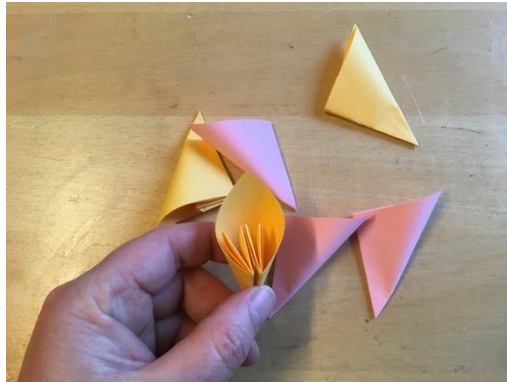
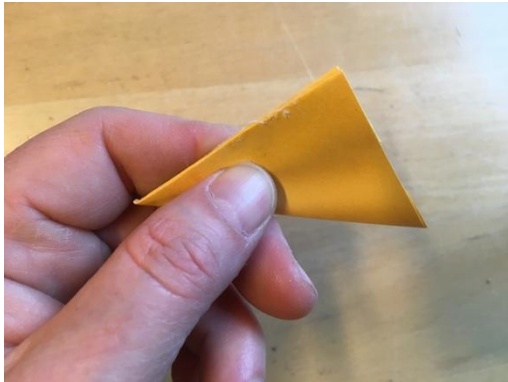
Fold the points inwards.



Fold in half along the crease. Repeat for the other side.



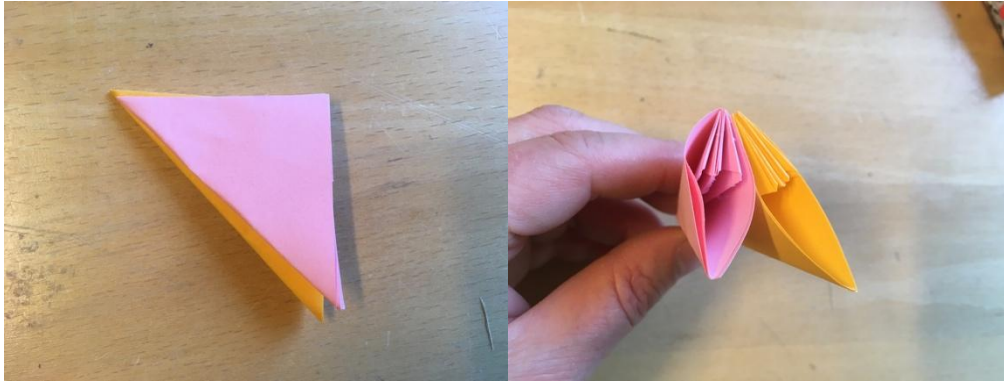
Fold in half inwards. Glue the inner flap only and stick together.



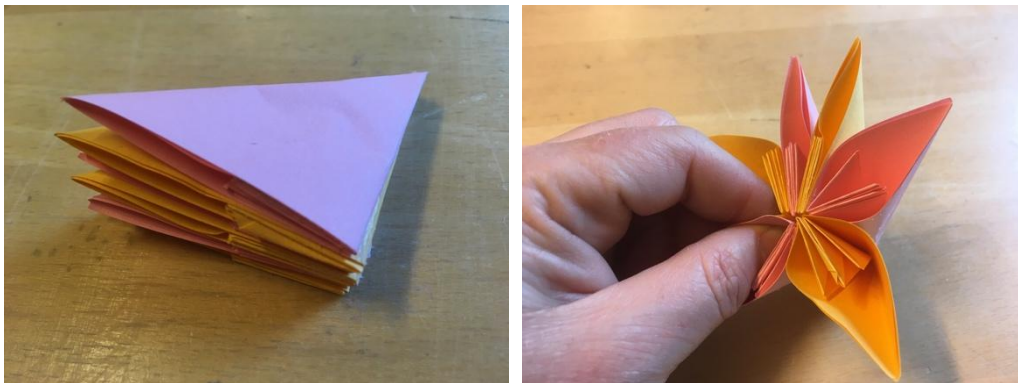
Hold for a moment so it holds. Pop out the paper to see the petal shape.



Repeat. A minimum of 6 petals are needed. Glue the petals together with a thin band of glue down the centre edge of the petal.



Repeat for all petals as shown.



When you connect the final edges hold tight to ensure it is properly glued.
